4. Electronically submit a post-conference reflection to the Director of PD by February 21, 2017. (Required format will be available on the OMEA website.)
5. Satisfactorily complete all requirements and receive an instructional hour certificate (10 hours) from the Ohio Music Education Association.

1. You must pre-register to participate in this program.
2. Update your Individual Professional Development Plan to include the OMEA IHCP and submit the plan to your LPDC for approval prior to attending the conference.
